
Cooking Teams Needed!

Cooks for Books is a cook-off with a storybook theme. All proceeds from Cooks for Books will go to Jackson County's Dolly Parton's Imagination Library Program. Imagination Library is a FREE program that allows ALL registered children in Jackson County to receive a FREE book every month from birth to 5 years of age. At this event, your cooking team can help us raise funds to continue this program and promote early literacy.

PARTICIPATING TEAMS WILL:

- Choose a children's book and select a recipe that reflects the theme of the story.
 (For example BOOK: Three Little Pigs; RECIPE: Three Little Pigs in a Blanket.)
- Develop a table display with themed decorations (costumes, props, signs) that bring the book to life.
- Prepare enough of the recipe for about 150 people to sample.
- Bring the prepared dish ready to serve and for people to vote on.
- Be provided one table and supplies (plates, spoons, forks, etc.) to serve their samples.

TO WIN:

- Recruit friends, family and coworkers to attend the event & vote for your recipe.
- Attendees pay \$5 to sample and get one vote. Additional votes are \$1 each. Those who are unable to attend may donate to your team in advance.
- The team who gets the most votes (raises the most \$) WINS! Second & third place awards will also be given.
- The winning team will receive a plaque & the privilege of signing the, "Cooks for Books Winning Team Apron".
